

DAYSPRING SUMMER PROJECTS 2026

Fairmont, WV

Purpose:

Dayspring is a place where people can come to serve no matter their ministry experience, age, or skill level. We minister to the surrounding community primarily through construction projects. In addition, we have opportunities for local community engagement, including Bible Clubs, sports camps, and nursing home ministry. Our unique ministry allows participants from various age groups to serve and grow together. Our main purpose is to love people the way Jesus did—by being present with a heart ready to listen, serving others through practical means, and building disciples.

Age/Level of Experience:

All ages and stages are welcome! Younger children are welcome, but parents and the team are responsible for their care and supervision. A minimum age of 13 is required for children participating without their parent. (Dayspring leadership must approve any exception.) This project is excellent for a first-time mission experience, but also provides unique servant heart development for more experienced mission teams.

Dates:

Week 1: June 6-13	Week 4: July 11-18

Half-Day Off:

Wednesday afternoon affords a timely break in the week's schedule. Teams may visit any number of local and state attractions. Bring spending money for the activity your group has chosen and for the evening meal.

Food & Lodging:

Teams stay in open bay cabins with bunk beds. The camp can house approximately 120 participants per week. Teams will need to bring towels and twin-size bed linens/pillow. Meals are provided from Saturday evening dinner until Saturday morning breakfast (with the exception of Wednesday evening dinner).

Spiritual Development:

Morning devotional times, prayer throughout the day, and an evening program encourage spiritual growth. A full evening worship time offers opportunities to worship God through the hearing of His Word, singing together, and times of prayer and sharing.

Project Orientation Trip (POT): May 1-2

Team leaders are required to attend this on-site orientation. This time is essential for team, construction and ministry preparation. Your project will be assigned at this time based upon your team's skill set and available projects. All costs for the POT are covered for team leaders, except for travel to/from Dayspring Camp. (*Additional team members may attend for \$50/person.*)

Travel:

Teams are responsible for travel to Fairmont and to/from the worksite.

Project Cost:

\$545/person (We offer family discounts. Please contact Lydia for more information.)

Kitchen Workers:

\$350/person (A limited number of workers are needed to assist with meal preparations during the week. Please email Lydia if you have someone interested.)
